

GAMES TO BE PLAYED DURING THE YEAR

4BBB (4 Ball Better Ball) Team of 2 players play individual Stableford. Best score for the hole is entered on scorecard.

PAR Over 'your par' - (Minus), 'your par' O (Square or Halved), lower than 'your par' + (Plus).

The Player with the highest result (normally most *pluses*) is the winner.

Split 6s Teams of 4 individually play 18 hole Stableford Holes 1 to 6 Record the best 3 scores for each hole Holes 7 to 12 Record the best 2 scores for each hole. Holes 13 to 18 Record the best score for each hole. Add these results together to obtain your team Stableford score.

Irish Teams Teams of 4 play 18 hole Stableford. . Par 3 - best player score.

Par 4 - best two scores. Par 5 - best three scores

Skins Each hole is played separately, and is won by the player with the best Stableford score on the hole - that golfer wins 'the skin' (i.e. 1 point). When two or more players tie the hole, then there is a 'jackpot' which carries over to the next hole (or a number of holes) until there is a winner who gets all the jackpot points.

Ambrose Threesomes Team of 3 players. All hit tee shots.

One ball is selected. The 3 players then hit from the selected spot with own ball, repeating until ball is holed. Each player must have 6 of their tee shots selected. From the gross score deduct 1/6th (or 1/8 if 4 players) of the aggregate of your handicaps to get the nett score for your team.
